ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Langston Junior Boys & Girls Golf Club is pleased to sponsor an academic scholarship program designed to help its members achieve their educational goals and aspirations. Any Junior Boys & Girls Golf Club member who has been admitted to an accredited U.S. college, university, or proprietary school is eligible for an award. The number and size of awards will be determined annually by the Board of Directors of the Langston Junior Boys & Girls Golf Club. The awards will be presented at the Opening Ceremony of the Langston Junior Boys & Girls Golf/ Hook-A-Kid-On-Golf Program each June.

In order to qualify for a Langston Scholarship, an applicant must:

- Be a member in good standing in a Langston Junior Golf Program;
- Currently enrolled on a full-time basis in school;
- Have maintained a 2.5 grade point average or better;
- Show proof of having been admitted to a post-secondary educational institution.

Students are expected to complete the attached application form, provide a one-page résumé and submit a 500 word essay. After careful consideration of all complete application packets, the Selection Committee will invite the top applicants for an interview.

For consideration, applicants must submit a complete application package **at 5:00pm EST on the Friday before Memorial Day** each year:

 - **Essays that are more than two pages will disqualify applicants from consideration.**
